TEAMS OF THE CENTURY

As part of the celebration of the College's Centenary, Teams of the Century were selected in sixteen of St Kevin's twenty four current sports. The sports chosen were selected on the basis of:

- An established history of participation and representation
- Being an APS sport
- A verifiable post-school record of past pupil participation

The selectors of the teams were given the task of putting together a theoretical team of the best Kevinians, past or present, to take into a contest in each sport.

Teams were selected according to current APS and other competition rules and regulations for each sport. This included:

- Team size
- Bench, interchange, and reserve numbers
- Event limitation in swimming
- Timetabling restrictions in Athletics
- The APS event schedule for Swimming and Athletics

In field sports, selectors were asked to place selected team members in position.

Court sports such as Badminton, Table Tennis and Tennis were asked to select players in rank order.



The Rowing crew was selected in seat order while the Cricket team was selected in batting order.

The Athletics and Swimming selections were on the basis of selecting one Open team.

Selectors had the option of choosing a Coach and or TIC in their sport if they felt there had been someone particularly noteworthy. These selections did not have to be Kevinians.

Selected team members had to be of good character.

Selectors could consider both school and post-school sporting performances in choosing members of their teams. There was no weighting given to either school or post-school sporting accomplishments. Selectors were empowered to pick whom they thought were the best possible team members.

Team of the Century members marked with an asterisk are deceased.

The selectors had a most difficult task, best reflected in the many good Kevinians who didn't make teams.
